### 4. Some of my customers want to donate bread to the shelter.

That's wonderful! Your customers will pay you - just like any other order - and KHK volunteers deliver the bread to a local shelter. There is a column on the order form where you can indicate the number of loaves for donation. If your customer is ordering online, there is also a field to designate donated loaves.

# 5. My neighbors and family want to order bread online.

# 6. Forms of payment?

Cash, checks. (payable to Kids Helping Kids), or order online with a credit card.

# 7. When is payment due from the seller to KHK?

All funds collected from your bread sales are due to KHK by 12/7/18. Please convert cash into checks if you are mailing us the money.

### 8. Do I need to collect payment when an order is placed?

No, but it is a good idea! Otherwise, you will collect it when you deliver the breads to them. In any case, payment is due to KHK by 12/7/18.
