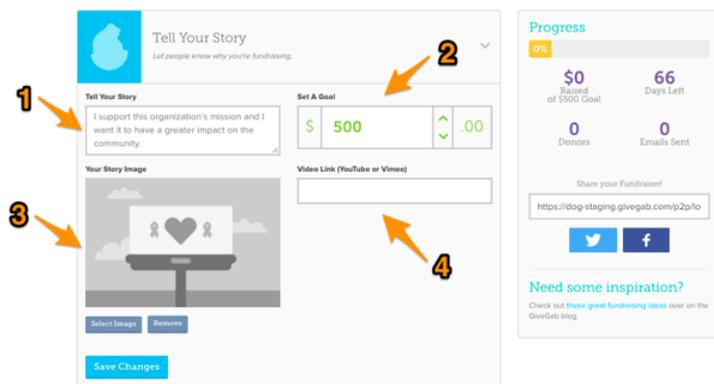


# How to Create a Giving Day Fundraising Page for Kids Helping Kids on the Give Gab donation platform

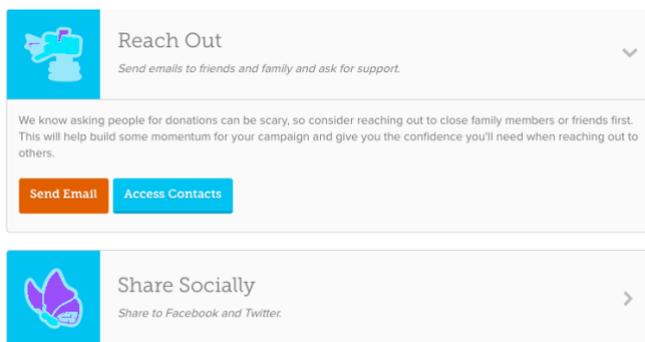
- 1) Visit our [profile](#) page on the Fairfield County Community Foundation website. Go to [www.fcgives.org](http://www.fcgives.org) and search for Kids Helping Kids.
- 2) Click on the **orange Fundraise** button on our profile page.
- 3) Enter your First and Last name as well as your e-mail address. Create a password. Write it down for safekeeping. Click Submit.
- 4) You will then get a Confirmation window that looks like this:



- 5) Click on the **blue Manage Fundraiser** button to personalize your page.
- 6) Re-enter your login credentials (e-mail and password.) Click on *Let's Go*.
- 7) You will then be directed to your Fundraising tool kit page.
- 8) Click on the smiley face to upload a picture of yourself.
- 9) Click on the "Tell Your Story" box.



- 10) Click on Save Changes
- 11) Please rally support around KHK by sending an e-mail to your family and friends. We suggest sending it out one week before Giving Day and also sending a reminder the day before.



- 12) **Most importantly, on February 28<sup>th</sup>** please share the link on social media, email or text! Remind your friends and family that it is Giving Day and ask them to make a donation!
